Future financial modelling of how this provision operates suggests that if no changes are made, it will become increasingly unaffordable. Therefore, it is proposed that a 25% minimum payment in Council Tax be adopted for 2018/19. Any revenue saving made in this way to be put towards offsetting the planned reduction in funding for the Library Service; children's centres; community Parks and restore funding for devolved local traffic schemes.	Working age claimants who are on low income or unemployed will be most affected. This proposal will remove some of the current protection to children and adults in receipt of some disability benefits, lone parents with children under 5, people in receipt of carers benefits or war pensions and section 7 homeless people/families, so it would have a negative impact on vulnerable people from some equalities communities. Reallocating funding to children's centres could have a positive impact on vulnerable women and children, disabled parents and disabled children and allocating funding to libraries (other than those already prioritised) would have a positive impact on older people and families.
