Note the schedule of devolved Section 106 contribution in Appendix 1 and the non devolved s106 for the NP area in Appendix 2. In addition the Neighbourhood Committee has a further £58, 774 - £60k (depending on the final cost of related schemes) to allocate following the Committees decision to fund Redcliffe Bridge at the December 2011 meeting.

3. Wellbeing Fund 2012-2013

There will be a wellbeing fund of £30,000 available to the Neighbourhood Committee. The Committee is asked to take a view on the following proposals:

Small Grants - For decision

- a) Allocate £21,000 to small grants (£7,000 per ward). Leaving £9,000 to commit later in the year for small grants or other NP work.
- b) If the Committee agrees to fund small grants it needs to confirm the priorities

for 2012/2013. The priorities for 2011/12 are as follows:

- i. Activities which are about young people making their voice heard in decision making so that young people of Ashley, Easton & Lawrence Hill have a greater stake in their communities. Proposals must be able to show they have been developed along side young people.
- ii. Proposals which foster positive relationships between children and young people from different neighbourhoods in particular but not exclusively St Pauls and Easton.
- iii. Local people having greater involvement and say where they live applications from residents/resident groups to improve where they live.
- iv. Events/activities bringing together people from different cultural backgrounds who would not normally come together.
- v. Sharing skills and knowledge projects, visits, skill swaps. Activities which help people share skills and or/knowledge particularly between groups who would not otherwise come together (it could be knowledge of recent changes in benefits, how to negotiate Facebook or fact finding mission to another area of Bristol or another city).
- c). Grants assessment process it is proposed to continue with the resident panel making recommendations to the Neighbourhood Committee.

Stapleton Road – For decision

2011/12 the Committee allocated £2,000 to support the administration of the Stapleton Road Working Group. This has paid for room hire, refreshments, stickers and posters.

It is recommended the Committee allocate a further £1,500 to support the ongoing work of the group in 2012/2013.
