#### SUMMARY

This report covers the second quarterly risk management review for 2013/14.

#### Policy

It was recently agreed by the Audit Committee for Directorate risk register reports to be presented as a main agenda item.

#### **Consultation:**

**Internal:** Officers from within the Directorate, including risk owners and the risk champion were consulted.

**External:** None necessary

### 1. Background

1.1 The Children First programme is addressing most areas of the business and will help to reduce the likelihood of several risks on the register. Some risks, however, such as risks to children in need, will never completely reduce due to the nature of the work involved.

#### 2. Quarter 2 Directorate risk register review

- 2.1 Appendix 1 provides full details of the current directorate risks and how these risks are being managed.
- 2.2 Currently there are 4 risks recorded on the corporate risk register and these are presented in order of highest current risk. 1 risk is demonstrating a current risk status as high:
  - Children in need CRR16
- 2.3 The remaining 3 risks are currently considered as medium or low risk when considering the effectiveness of current mitigation in place to manage the risk.
- 2.4 At its January 2013 meeting, the Committee requested inclusion of 'target risk' and the direction of travel since the previous quarter to be included and this analysis has progressed and is shown in the appendices. The addition of this information identifies that;
  - Educational attainment CRR10 and Delivery of the capital programme CRR20 can be reduced to 'low risk' status
  - Children in need CRR16 can be reduced to a 'medium risk' status
  - Potential unitary charge shortfall CRR32 will remain 'medium risk'
- 2.5 There is now an opportunity to develop the risk management methodology and make it more effective in reducing 'Current risk' levels. Ongoing work is now required by Risk Owners to review and challenge the information in the register and the effectiveness of the risk management strategies in respect of each risk.
- 2.6 The risk register is considered by the Directorate Leadership Team as part of a quarterly performance report.

#### 3. Risk Assessment

3.1 A robust and effective risk management process serves to minimise the risk of failures in the Council's service provision. It supports the internal control environment and governance arrangements, whilst providing for Member involvement in ensuring that risks facing the Council are properly addressed and managed.

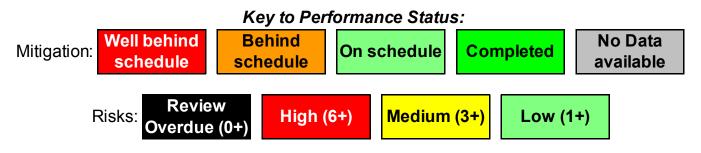
