1.4 Clean and Green – budget £1500

The way Clean and Green is allocated has changed slightly this financial year; the NP was allocated £1500 as per previous years added to last years underspends totals for this year are

Avonmouth - £450 Shirehampton - £375 Sea Mills - £650 Lawrence Weston - £375

In addition to this we have bid into the £19,000 City Wide Pot. Results of this will be made public in mid to late October.

1.4.1 The projects that Avonmouth and Kingsweston bid for were

1. One picnic bench for Napier Sq Park – project cost £1405.20

Request that if successful £250 from the Clean and Green budget is allocated to act as match funding from the Avonmouth allocation

2. Two benches and two wheelchair accessible picnic table, for the yellow brick rd. – project cost £12672.88 (Clean and Green City Wide Pot request £5042)

Request that if Successful £100 from the Clean and Green Budget is allocated to act as match funding from the Avonmouth allocation and £275 is allocated from the Shirehampton allocation plus S10s funds discussed

below.

Recommendation 3: To discuss and consider allocation of up to £625 of Clean and Green Devolved Funding to act as match funding to the City Wide projects if successful.

1.5 S106 funds. Up date on current S106 funding - AppendixB

1.5.1 The Yellow Brick Road

As discussed above the submission for the seating and signing along the Yellow Brick Rd is a very accessible route between the two villages of Avonmouth and Shirehampton, a recent Accessibility Audit reported that; however there are no places for people to rest take in the views or have a picnic. There are several paved places were benches could be situated along the path. This would enable older residents and wheelchair users to enjoy the views and take exercise.

Next year is also the festival of the river and this project will enhance the river offer in readiness for this festival.

The Wild City Access Audit has identified the following recommendations

Suggested improvements for Lamplighters Marsh

- 1. Two picnic tables and bins at appropriate viewing points
- 2. Benches along the length of the path for resting (in-line with the 'Countryside for All access standards)
- 3. Additional bins, including dog waste bins at the two entrance points
- 4. Regular cutting back of brambles along path edge
- 5. In the long-term consider:
- the prospect for additional small circular routes at the western end allied to the provision of some benches (however, this must be compatible with the objectives of any existing ecological management plan)
- a dedicated pedestrian/cycle route under the Station Road Bridge.
- improved welcome signage at the western end of the site
- the provision of information boards at the park and ride and also at Shirehampton Station.
- off-site signing to the site aligned to improved, safer pedestrian/cycle access to the site (at both ends)
- Align extra funding with the potential re-development of the pub adjacent to the eastern entrance to the site.

Accessibility to exciting Green Space is one of the Priorities in the Avonmouth and Kingsweston Green Space Plan

Decision proposed - to allocate £7255.78 S106 funds to the Yellow Brick Road Project in Shirehampton from the 07/01402 / Myrtle Drive, Shirehampton / ZCD...832 development should the funding from the Clean and Green project be successful,

Recommendation 4: To discuss and consider to allocation of S106 funding to match fund the Yellow Brick Road Project

1.5.2 - Shire Public Hall

Shire Public Hall has recently been redecorated inside, paid for by the trustees. However this work is being undermined by the state of repair of the windows, which in some cases are leaking and in need of replacement, and the state of repair of the external fabric of the building which is very poor. Work to rectify this is required urgently. The Hall also requires work to the roof, however this work is not so urgent.

Bristol City Council have agreed to pay £25000 towards these works, and the trustees have agreed to fund up to £10,000 towards this work. The repair works for replacing faulty windows and repairing the fabric of the building (excluding the roof) the cost has been quoted at £28000, however it is expected that there will be more work needed as closer inspection could reveal that more of the windows need replacing rather than repairing.

The S106 funding allocated to repairs for the Shire Public Hall (06/03804 / Former Portway Day Centre, Shirehampton / ZCD... 509) amounts to £13,095.23. It is not envisaged that all of this will be required.

As the work is external it is important that it is carried out before the onset of winter, and it is envisaged that work will start at the beginning of September

Decision proposed: to allocate the S106 funds to pay for any needed shortfall and to save the remainder for future works as and when they will be required.

Recommendation 5: To discuss and consider allocation of S106 funding towards the Shire Public Hall Repairs
