1 Minor Traffic Schemes –

- 1a Kingsweston Rd, Kingsweston Ln all signage has been installed. The resurfacing needs to be looked at as a bigger piece of work in the new financial due to the currently state of repair.
- 1b Westbury Ln designs are currently being prepared and will be tabled on the night if ready
- 1c At the last meeting the Committee agreed to allocate some of the S106 funds to exploring possibilities for making Kingsweston Ln more cycle and pedestrian friendly. S106 05/04807/meerbank, Kingsweston Lane, Avonmouth/ZCD624 is worth £66330.32. As a result of the high profile Lawrence Weston has (linked to the Community Planning day of 10th October) £100,000 has been set aside to add value to this. Discussions are also underway with Seven Net and Local Sustainable Transport Fund Coordinator for further investment. Once funding has been finalised options will be consulted on.

1.2 Carriageway resurfacing – Allocation £8,400 Severn Road (Ableton to Motorway) – complete

1.3 Footway Resurfacing - £43,000 budget
