Bishopston, Cotham and Redland Neighbourhood Partnership meeting 21st January 2012 Residents' Parking Scheme update

Background

- The Cotham RPS area became operational in December 2012.
- The scheme prioritises parking in the area for local residents, businesses and their visitors. This is achieved by marking out parking places on the road and allocating them to permit holders. There is also some pay & display parking in the area which is provided for people visiting shops, businesses and other local facilities.

Next steps

- The Cotham scheme will be reviewed in June 2013.
- This provides an opportunity for local residents and businesses to let us know how the scheme is working once it has been in place for a reasonable period of time. We will carefully consider all of the feedback received with a view to implementing any changes towards the end of 2013-14.
- Any minor boundary adjustments that are requested will be considered as part of this process.

Potential additional areas

- We are also committed to consulting neighbouring residential areas about parking issues and have already begun surveying nearby streets.
- Once this process has been completed, we will carry out informal consultation about parking in the northern part of Cotham and in Redland. We anticipate this taking place just before the Cotham review.
- If additional RPS areas are to be developed, these could be delivered within a similar timeframe to the alterations to the existing Cotham scheme.
