1. WELCOME, INTRODUCTIONS AND APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

3. PUBLIC FORUM

There were no items of public forum business.

4. PARKS CAPITAL STIMULUS FUND – MATCH FUNDING REPORT

Members were provided with a brief introduction to the report. They were advised that the purpose of the meeting was to reallocate funding to ensure that the S106 contribution in relation to the development at 288 Gloucester Road be utilised before the expiry date. The Committee received assurances that their decision would not affect the future of the previously agreed projects at St Andrews Park, which would instead be funded from another City Council budget.

Councillor Knott then moved the officer recommendation and was seconded by Councillor Willingham. On being put to the vote there was unanimous support. It was therefore;

RESOLVED:

(1) That the Neighbourhood Committee rescind its decision, made at the meeting on 22nd October 2012, regarding the allocation of £8,683.19 S106 of funds from the development at 288 Gloucester Road development;

(2) that the £8,683.19 of S106 funds from the 288 Gloucester Road development be allocated to the Council's Capital Stimulus project to upgrade the toilet facilities at The Ardagh.
