# Statement agreed at the Neighbourhoods and Scrutiny Commission meeting of the 20<sup>th</sup> November 2013

That the Mayor and Cabinet be advised that the Neighbourhoods & Scrutiny Commission does not support the proposal to lease the lower two basement floors (of the original Holden Library) of the Bristol Central Library to the Cathedral Primary School.

The Commission found that the current proposal left unanswered questions around:

- the suitability of the site for its proposed use,
- its impact on the availability of school places for local children,
- the environmental impact of the building itself and the transport of children to and from the school,
- the potential negative effect on users of the reference library when the bulk of the reference material is stored off- site.

The Commission was not satisfied that that the Equality Impact Assessments provided an adequate impact assessment of these proposals on library users, library staff and most importantly young people.
