**Cabot & Clifton Local Traffic Schemes  
Recommendations from the Traffic Sub Group  
27<sup>th</sup> November 2012**

The Traffic and Transport Sub Group met on the 27<sup>th</sup> November 2012 to consider the revised shortlisted schemes and to ask more detailed and technical questions to our Traffic representative that covers our NP area. The group also considered an additional 6 schemes that have come to light since the first meeting which took place in September.

The Group agreed their Terms of Reference which will be taken to be formally agreed at the next Neighbourhood Partnership meeting in January 2013.

The Group recommended that they should prioritise schemes over a 2 year period therefore using this year's budget (£30,000) plus next year's budget (£25,000).

It was agreed that the group, probably at the January NP meeting, would agree a 'window' to invite applications to be considered for the remainder of the unallocated budget.

The Group also agreed to release £2,250 for the Senior Traffic Engineer for the NP Area to spend at his discretion on providing minor signs and lines.

It was stressed that once the annual workplan had been formulated and agreed, then the group would also consider other relevant Traffic and Transport issues and not solely focus on devolved budgets.

Below are the list of schemes that the Traffic and Transport Sub Group have prioritised and recommend for funding by the Neighbourhood Committee. These are estimated to cost £40,800 which leaves around £16,450 to allocate.
