#### Recommendations:

1. To note the contents of the report.

The total devolved budget for 2013/2014 for the Cabot, Clifton & Clifton East Neighbourhood Partnership including Section 106 developer contributions is £492,786.56. Below is a breakdown and update for each category.

#### 1. Minor Traffic Schemes

**Budget: Minor Traffic Schemes - £52,800** 

At the Cabot, Clifton & Clifton East NP meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2013, the Neighbourhood Committee agreed the recommendations from the Traffic & Transport Sub Group as well as agreeing the Pembroke Road Crossing. The schemes are based on the devolved funding for 2012 / 2013 & 2013 / 2014. This means that the Neighbourhood Partnership and Committee are unable to allocate any further devolved funding until receiving confirmation that we will get funding for 2014 / 2015.

Also at the NP in March 2013, we received a report from the Highways Department asking for a pause in decision making and delivery with regards to the Minor Traffic Schemes. An update on what schemes could be delivered this year – 2013/2014 – was requested:
