The above reflects levels of crime reported to Police across the entire Bristol South Local Policing area. We have seen a small decrease in dwelling burglary, but would note that this equates to 5 fewer offences over the five months YTD. There has been a significant increase in the recording of offences as racially or religiously aggravated, partly due to better confidence in reporting issues but also attributable to some concerning cases whereby victims have been targeted on numerous occasions. The other figure worthy of note is the continuing rise in incidents of violence against the person offences, up almost 54% across the Bristol South area.

The second table details the number of "incidents" recorded by Police. It is important to bear in mind that several people might report the same incident, but each report would be counted in the above list. However, as a comparison year on year, it does now seem to show a reduction in reports of anti-social behaviour (ASB). As before, I would caution against reading too much into this though, because it might simply be down to better recording of incidents as crimes (particularly violence against the person) rather than ASB.

Overall numbers of crime across the partnership area remain stable, with no significant increases or decreases to note.

Operation Biker has now been back, and fully operational for approximately 14 months. We now utilise PCSOs on the off-road bikes, allowing much better coverage and visibility of officers

The OP-BIKER team have successfully removed motorcycles using green spaces around the south Bristol area including

HENGROVE LEISURE PARK and THE GREEN SPACE

DUNDRY SLOPES/CROSSCOMBE DRIVE

A38 BEDMINSTER DOWN GREEN SPACE

STOCKWOOD OPEN SPACE /OLD REDS RUBY PITCHES

Vehicles issued warnings include

A Racing 250cc Go Kart, Mopeds and Off road motorcycles (being used on and off road).

The two officers dedicated to the operation have issued 6 "section 59" warnings for inappropriate use, and have most recently seized a Moped where the bike was being ridden around with no insurance no MOT no TAX and the rider had no licence as they were disqualified! That offence occurred in Hartcliffe. The team have also recovered stolen Motorcycles which have been used anti-socially and used illegally before being hidden in wooded areas, and have also assisted in missing person searches as they cover open spaces easier than officers on foot.
