Recommendation:

- a) To **agree** to fund No motorbike/vehicle stencils to use in and around the Dundry View Neighbourhood Partnership area.
- 1. Safe and empowered Dundry View is a priority on the Neighbourhood Plan and includes ASB and illegal motorbike use
 - 1.1. A problem solving plan with colleagues and partners particularly the Police around nuisance motorbike use has been produced and is looking at a long term sustainable solution.
 - 1.2. At the September Hartcliffe Forum residents raised the issue of nuisance bikes and was frustrated by the lack of progress to deal with the ASB
 - 1.3. The Crime and Community Safety report (Agenda item 10) details some of the recent enforcement work that has happened in regard to the bike ASB
 - 1.4. It has been noted that currently there are few signs in Dundry View showing that motorbike and quad use is not allowed on the open green spaces or parks in the area.

- 2. The residents who attended the Hartcliffe Forum have asked for the Partnership to fund stencils which are reusable which show that motor vehicle use is not permitted on the green spaces or in the park.
- 3. Stencils have been produced previously for the stop dog fouling campaign at a cost of £170 for 6, a temporary vegetable based paint is used in conjunction with the stencils in areas of need and can be reapplied when necessary.
- 4. We are requesting the partnership fund a set of stencils as a temporary measure while further work takes place on the problem solving plan. At a cost of no more than £200.
