RECOMMENDATION

To approve the polling districts and places for all wards in Bristol as listed in the schedule of polling districts and polling places.

Summary

The report lists all polling districts for elections in Bristol to come into force from May 2016. Members are asked to approve these polling districts and the polling places, in all cases listed as 'the whole of the polling place'. Also included for information are lists of the polling stations. Decisions on polling stations are taken by the Acting Returning Officer.

The significant issues in the report are:

Neither the boundaries of parliamentary constituencies nor the local ward boundaries are part of the review

It is considered expedient to designate polling places as polling districts thus ensuring that the Returning Officer is able to properly exercise her statutory discretion in the identification of polling stations within those areas, though prior to major elections the Returning Officer will advise political parties of the situation of the actual polling stations used, and will consider any comments made.

Policy

Consultation

A six week public consultation was held from 1 September to 13 October 2015.

In addition to this open public consultation the following internal and external persons were directly consulted:

- 2.3 The Mayor of the City and County of Bristol.
- 2.4 The Acting Returning Officer for all four constituencies.
- 2.5 Bristol City Council – Equalities and Social Inclusion Team.

Electoral Services have worked with Geographical Information Systems to produce the new polling district boundaries, and have consulted with Equalities and Neighbourhood Partnerships teams.

Members have been consulted through a programme of engagement with briefing sessions and one-to-one meetings. Members have given input either directly or through the consultation process.

3. External

- 3.1** All MEPS for the authority area.
- 3.2** All MPs for the authority area.
- 3.3** The Police and Crime Commissioner.
- 3.4** Political parties active within the authority area
- 3.5** Disability and age related equality organisations within the authorities area.
- 3.6** VOSCUR.

The public consultation elicited 118 responses, each of which has been considered and changes made to the proposals where practicable.

Context

- 4.** The Local Government Boundary Commission for England undertook a review of wards in Bristol. The new arrangements consist of 70 councillors representing 5 three-member wards, 26 two-member wards and 3 single member wards. Following that review, BCC Electoral Services have reviewed all polling districts and places in the city.
- 5.** The primary considerations in making changes to polling district boundaries are firstly a maximum of 1,500 electors attending each polling station (on projected figures); secondly good accessible venues used as polling stations; and thirdly every polling station to sit within its

ward.

6. Other key considerations in drawing up the polling districts are to avoid electors having difficult or dangerous journeys to their polling station or having to travel long distances; avoiding a situation where electors have to walk past another polling station to reach their own; an aim to avoid the use of portacabins wherever possible due to the expense, and an aim to minimise the use of secondary schools to avoid disruption.
7. The requirement for a maximum of 1,500 electors attending each station is in order to reduce queues at polling stations whilst operating in keeping with Electoral Commission guidance. Guidance states that polling station registers may not be 'split' between poll clerks, meaning that only one elector can be processed at any one time. Guidance also states that as the number of electors per station increases, so must the number of station staff. To have an increased number of staff, but with only two poll clerks employed productively, is not an efficient use of staff. We have opted for the most efficient use of staff which is for the majority of polling stations to have only one Presiding Officer and two Poll Clerks.
8. We also anticipate that future guidance may bring the maximum number of station voters down. To strike a balance we have aimed for a maximum of 1,500 electors attending each station.
9. This approach has led to an increased number of polling stations, and to make use of the best facilities we have looked to use dual stations where that is the best option. Only venues that are suitable, and large enough, will be used as dual stations. A dual station is where the venue holds two polling stations within one building, either in two distinct rooms or in a larger room split into two. In either case the two stations are run entirely separately with a different set of staff for each, with each led by its own Presiding Officer, and with voters directed clearly to the correct station for their polling district.

10. Electoral Services have undertaken a comprehensive review of all existing and identified potential venues which could serve as polling stations. The mandatory criteria used for assessing venues was a venue accessible to all; a venue within 1 mile walking distance for all electors of the district; and no more than 1,500 electors at each polling station on projected figures for 2020.
11. Other key considerations in reviewing venues were DDA compliance; to minimise the use of portacabins; to use polling stations graded as good or excellent; and to use polling stations within the polling district wherever possible.
12. There are three instances where Parliamentary constituency boundaries are not coterminous with the new ward boundaries. In two of these cases we have labelled the separate parts to the polling district affected, for example 'STWA1' and 'STWA2' for the two parts of the polling district STWA in Stockwood. The authority is legally obliged to create a separate polling station register for these electors in the event of any Parliamentary election. In the third case we have made the area its own polling district which avoids the need for further labelling.

Proposal

13. To approve the polling districts and places for all wards in Bristol as listed in the schedule of polling districts and polling places:
 - 13.1. 231 polling districts as set out in the individual ward maps
 - 13.2. Each polling district to have its own polling place designated as 'the whole of the polling district'.
14. These polling districts will be served by 231 polling stations, 51 of which are dual stations. Polling stations are also set out in the individual ward

maps, with a blue marker showing an ordinary polling station and a pink marker showing a dual polling station. The decision on polling stations is taken by the Acting Returning Officer, but the details are included here for reference and to help inform the decision on polling districts and places.

Other Options Considered

15. All options proposed through internal and external consultation have been considered against the criteria set out in this report. Wherever a proposal has not been implemented Electoral Services will respond to the individual or group to explain why it has not been taken forward in the context of these criteria.

Risk Assessment

16. The result of not instituting new polling districts would be to prevent the running of the May 2016 election. Polling districts need to be in place to administer and run the election, and any delay will impact all work-streams and incur a very high risk to the delivery of the election.

Public Sector Equality Duties

8a) Before making a decision, section 149 Equality Act 2010 requires that each decision-maker considers the need to promote equality for persons with the following “protected characteristics”: age, disability, gender reassignment, pregnancy and maternity, race, religion or belief, sex, sexual orientation. Each decision-maker must, therefore, have due regard to the need to:

i) Eliminate discrimination, harassment, victimisation and any other conduct prohibited under the Equality Act 2010.

ii) Advance equality of opportunity between persons who share a relevant protected characteristic and those who do not share it. This involves having due regard, in particular, to the need to --

- remove or minimise disadvantage suffered by persons who share a relevant protected characteristic;
- take steps to meet the needs of persons who share a relevant protected characteristic that are different from the needs of people who do not share it (in relation to disabled people, this includes, in particular, steps to take account of disabled persons' disabilities);
- encourage persons who share a protected characteristic to participate in public life or in any other activity in which participation by such persons is disproportionately low.

iii) Foster good relations between persons who share a relevant protected characteristic and those who do not share it. This involves having due regard, in particular, to the need to –

- tackle prejudice; and
- promote understanding.

8b) The purpose of this review is to ensure that polling is accessible for all electors and thus that polling places and polling districts are set up to enable the Returning Officer to identify polling stations that meet this aim.

Legal and Resource Implications

Legal

Section 18 of the Representation of the People Act 1983 requires the Council to review the way it divides its area into polling districts and to identify a polling place for each district.

When reviewing polling districts, the authority must seek to ensure that all electors in a constituency in its area have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances.

When designating polling places, the following rules apply;

(a) the authority must seek to ensure that all electors in a constituency in its area have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable in the circumstances; .

(b) the authority must seek to ensure that so far as is reasonable and practicable every polling place for which it is responsible is accessible to electors who are disabled;

(c) the authority must have regard to the accessibility to disabled persons of potential polling stations in any place which it is considering designating as a polling place or the designation of which as a polling place it is reviewing; .

(d) the polling place for a polling district must be an area in the district, unless special circumstances make it desirable to designate an area wholly or partly outside the district; .

(e) the polling place for a polling district must be small enough to indicate to electors in different parts of the district how they will be able to reach the polling station.

The proposals in this report meet the legislative requirements and accommodate the changes arising from the recent boundary review.
