The Awards Panel comprised: Jo Hargreaves, Celia Phipps*, Lesley Collins*, Helen Thomas*, Chris Bennett, Viv Brinson with Ben Barker* as non-voting coordinator. GBCP Board members are marked*. This Awards Panel was a small one, ie the turn-out was rather disappointing, both from board and non-board folk, but, many thanks to those who came.

Conditions and other comments.

Applications were graded on a five point range with 5 being the highest mark. No application received less than a 3 average.

Item 1. Money to be payable only when Network Rail and other necessary permissions are given. Had there been sufficient money this application would have received the full sum requested. However, it is hoped that other sources, eg Clean & Green Fund, Community Chest may be available to make up the difference, if required.

Item 3. It is still unclear if BCC will make the proposed community orchard site available. The money will therefore be retained until BCC's position is known, or, a suitable alternative site is identified 'in a reasonable time', ie during 2015.

Item 5. There was a discussion about the best 3 sites and whether or not the original 3 were the most appropriate. The applicant has already agreed to look again at this issue and will talk to GBCP about a balanced and accessible approach.

Item 6. Only the Bedminster Toilet Map was agreed and the applicant will need to find the missing 30p. However, the remaining part of the application stays on the table.

It is possible that not all these conditions will be met or that other factors will prevent a project going ahead. Money saved in this case will be used to support project 1 (up to an additional £550) and project 6 as required. Prioritisation will be in that order. The situation will be reviewed in April 2015.
