RECOMMENDATION

To note the contents of the report

The Community Partnership's Mobility & Transport Sub Group has met once since the beginning of 2016.

The sub group have agreed the following two objectives for the coming months:

1. To continue to use the Traffic Choices website to manage local requests for changes to the highways

There are currently 33 issues reported to the local authority and captured on the site.

 The sub group acknowledge the limited resources from the council to deliver traffic schemes. Currently, GBCP is entitled to one devolved traffic scheme a year. Therefore, the sub group have prioritised Identifying one or two traffic hotspots that may benefit from more creative solutions, rather than the more traditional intervention, such as speed humps, double yellow lines etc.

The sub group wish to explore using one of the hotspots to test whether creative solutions are just as effective as the traditional approach. The solutions could take the form of art work, strategically placed planters, etc.
