#### Actions from the ESG to date

- Discussions were had about plans for Patchworks community group to install a community orchard, this is now completed and the orchard installed.
- Tom Penn (Parks Officer BCC) came to a meeting to discuss the Grounds Maintenance survey it was identified that some area are difficult to maintain particularly slopes.
- Gari Garnson (Cycling ambition projects officer BCC) came to present proposals for improving the cycling route along the Malago Greenway. The ESG invited Matt Collis (Avon wild life trust) to look at the impact to wildlife this could have.
- Matt Collis (Avon wild life trust) talked to the group about plans for 'My Wild Bedminster'.
- The ESG looked at 'hot spots' with regards to fly tipping where community action could be focused for the future.

- Members of the ESG met with Tracey Morgan (BCC Waste manager)
  as part of plans to tackle fly tipping and improve street clutter with
  regards to street bins, as part of 'Lets walk Bedminster' project. This
  will be a pilot for the city; if it works the pilot will be rolled out
  across the city with community groups leading the way.

- ESG looked at S106 funds as it is and are looking at how it should be taken forward in the next financial year.
