

Community Food Project Proposal at Woodcroft Road

Proposal from Frank Grundy-White - Local resident, with support from Steve Clampin, Allotments Manager - Bristol City Council

It is proposed to create a community food project at the site of the paddock on Woodcroft Road, Broomhill. Central to the concept is community involvement, with public meetings, group meetings and consensus decisions. The site would lend itself well to a community orchard. The intention is to offer free gardening classes to the local community, with the opportunity to develop the site into a harvest share, Community Supported Agriculture (CSA), CoOp, and/or community orchard. A number of similar projects have been set up across the City, proving to be successful in bringing the local community together and providing sustainable food growing and learning opportunities.

Neighbourhood Partnership support is sought for this community engaging project. A temporary license will be issued, if there is support from the Neighbourhood Partnership.
