No.	Location	Type of Issue	Possible Remedy	Approx Cost	Approx Timescale (if agreed at Oct NP)
1	Church Hill out onto Bath Road.	Traffic getting blocked - there used to be double yellow lines and yellow box but now the traffic backs up and gets blocked			
2	Callington Road (could be in Knowle)	Pedestrian refuge island can't be approached without walking across grass – this is too muddy sometimes			
<mark>3</mark>	Emery Road Roundabout	Can it be raised			
<mark>4</mark>	Birchwood Road	Lacking of safe crossing place			

		There is £31577.14 to spend on crossings for Birchwood Road. NP will ask Highways to prioritise this project for the area. May be able to pay for 2 crossings (need to check with highways for quotes)		
5	<mark>Regency</mark> Drive	Lack of safe crossing place Whitmore/Capgrave – mid road island but no crossing		
6	Wootton Road / St.Annes Road Vehicle speeds and pedestrian safety	Vehicle speeds and pedestrian safety		

7	Talbot Road	Junctions with Lodway Road and Thiery Road (visibility) and adjacent to pedestrian / cycle route to Tesco (pedestrian safety) Vehicle speeds and visibility / pedestrian safety		
8	Sandy Park road on LHS looking up hill outside houses with driveways near post office	Parking on Sandy Park Road just up from post office (up hill) – damaging pavement, needs bollards		
<mark>9</mark>	Broomhill Road	Parking issues
