Arnos Court Park BMX Track Update

Following the public meeting held at Arnos Manor Hotel on Monday 4th February 2013, a revised approach to the location and construction of the BMX Pump Track at Arnos Court Park is being taken.

A site visit with Councillors, Planning Officer, Architrail, Neighbourhood Partnership and Neighbourhood Engagement representatives took place on 18th February 2013. As a result, it is no longer intended to locate the BMX Pump Track on the 'Kings Road' side of the park.

Architrail are in the process of providing revised costings for the new location.

The track will now be located in the flat section of the park, adjacent to the football goal posts, on the HTV Studio side of the park, as detailed on the site map. The final location, within this area of the park will be confirmed following the completion of the Planning Application.

The Planning Application Process requires Bristol City Council to complete a Pre-Planning Application, which takes four weeks to complete, prior to a full Planning Application being submitted, that will take a further eight weeks. If requests for information or objections are raised during this process, these timescales may increase.

Local residents will be consulted and have the opportunity to raise any concerns during the Planning Application Process. Based on this approach, and if lengthy delays are not encountered during the Planning Application Process the construction of the track will be in June/ July 2013.


