1. Highways Schemes 2013 - 14

At the June 2013 NP meet the agreement was not to prioritise schemes for 2013/14 as there is a backlog of undelivered Transport schemes.

Please see below for a full update as to the progress for all the Transport schemes for the Greater Brislington NP.
