1. The Wellbeing Panel met on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2013. In total the panel considered 9 applications. Summary appraisal sheets for all applications are shown in appendices 1 to 10, including the appraisal sheet for the Hillfields Luncheon Club, which was carried over from the December NP meeting.

### Part 3: The NC is asked to approve applications supported from contingency.

- 2. In June 2010, the partnership agreed to process applications from local community groups, which qualify for "exceptional circumstance" criteria. Maximum amount groups could apply for was caped to £1,000 and the maximum amount that can be processed was restricted to £3,000. The purpose is to support local community groups who wish to organise a community event/activity under very tight timescales.

4. If the Neighbourhood Committee approves the Wellbeing Panel's maximum recommendation (£16,655.48), the Greater Fishponds Neighbourhood Partnership will have £0 of Wellbeing budget remaining to spend for the remainder of this financial year. In the event the Neighbourhood Committee approves full asking amounts requested by community groups (£20,986.18), the Neighbourhood Committee will be committing £4,330.70 of the 2013/14 Wellbeing Budget. The Neighbourhood Partnership will have £25,669.30 remaining.

#### **Legal Information**

When councillors decide how the wellbeing fund is spent they should have due regard to the public sector equality duty that applies to all public bodies. This duty is contained in the Equality Act 2010 and came in to force on 6 April 2011. It replaces previous equality duties under the Sex Discrimination, Race Relations and Disability Discrimination Acts.

The duty means that councillors are required to have due regard to the need to:

- Eliminate unlawful discrimination, harassment and victimisation and other conduct prohibited under the Act
- Promote equality of opportunity between different groups
- Foster good relations between people from different groups

The duty covers the following protected characteristics:

- Disability
- Sexual orientation
- Age
- Gender reassignment
- Religion and belief
- Sex
- Race
- Pregnancy and maternity

It also applies to marriage and civil partnership, but only in respect of the requirement to eliminate discrimination and harassment.
