1. Performance

The above reflects levels of crime reported to Police across both wards at the end of Jan 2015. We continue to see a reduction in dwelling burglaries, which is very welcome (and somewhat against the trend for other areas of South Bristol). Theft of motor vehicles has doubled, but this is based upon a very low number overall the year before. Other than that, the figures are fairly consistent with trends across South Bristol.
