#### 1. NP Plan Review:

1.1 The NP Plan includes a review process to assess what has been delivered and consider any new issues, input from new communities and to refine the delivery of priorities in the light of the experience of the year since the adoption of the NP Plan.

- 1.2: The Ward Boundary Review has created very concrete changes in the focus of the Henbury, Brentry & Southmead Plan: the new NP is larger and includes parts of the former Westbury-on-Trym Ward. Some of their issues will need to be passed over to include in our Plan. Similarly parts of Southmead (Charlton Mead) will become Henbury/Brentry. The new Henbury & Brentry Community Plan and its priorities need to be incorporated into our Plan. New funds are becoming available for Parks/Open Spaces and the NP needs to define it's improvement/investment priorities to make the best use of the opportunities. Finally, the first version of the NP Plan was developed with acknowledged shortcomings in engagement and input from some parts of the community and an explicit commitment was made to do more work to understand and include Young People's priorities and engagement.
- 1.3 Recommendation: That the NP agrees to review its Plan and to undertake specific work with young people during the March- June 2016 period as a priority and to bring a new edition of the Plan to the 28<sup>th</sup> June NP meeting for adoption.
