28.10/13 SECTION 106 REPORT – UPDATE ON PUBLIC ART

The Neighbourhood Partnership considered a report of the City Design Manager (agenda item no. 4) setting out the section 106 report – update on public art.

Ariaf Hussain introduced the report and summarised it for everyone. He summarised the meetings that have been held to find a way forward. He confirmed that the film project would not now proceed. He stated that it was proposed to reduce the Marketing Budget by £5,000 from £16,000 to £11,000 and increase the Contingency Budget by £5,000 from £18,908 to £23,908. This was agreed.

Councillor Doubell confirmed that Ariaf Hussain and Andrew Gibbons have worked very hard to move the

project forward. She also noted that the Nils Norman project is ready to proceed.

Councillor Clark stated that there must be a contingency plan to ensure that the amount of £70,000 is committed or spent by 4th November 2013. This was agreed.

It was therefore

RESOLVED -

- (1) that the steps that will be undertaken to progress the s106 Public Art programme for Hengrove be noted, as agreed at the NP meeting on 18th September 2013;
- (2) that the expenditure profile indicating the funding allocated for the concept, design and delivery stages of each project commission for the arts programme for Hengrove ward be agreed subject to the Marketing Budget being reduced by £5,000 from £16,000 to £11,000 and the Contingency Budget increased by £5,000 from £18,908 to £23,908; and
- (3) that a contingency plan be developed to ensure the amount of £70,000 is committed or spent by 4th November 2013.
