RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Comments are sought from the NP members as to the proposed activities and costs that are being proposed by providers
- 2. The Neighbourhood Committee is asked to agree which activities to fund through the Well Being funding.
- 3. Subject to the amount allocated to a Youth Programme, the Neighbourhood Committee is asked approve up to £2,000 for the production of publicity and promotional material for the yearlong youth programme.
- 1. Stockwood, Hengrove & Whitchurch Neighbourhood Partnership has potentially £23,676.44 available unallocated funding in the Wellbeing budget following allocation of the Well Being Applications in December 2013.

- 3. As such the NP team has been targeting potential applicants and has brought forward proposals that target young people's activities with the NP area
- 4. A number of development meetings have been held by the Area Coordinator with a range of providers (including local youth providers, churches, schools and city wide organisations.
- 5. Attached are a range of actives that the providers have identified as potential activities that could be supported by the NP
- 6. This papers seeks guidance and influence from NP members as to the proposed activities and costs that are being proposed by providers
- 7. The Neighbourhood Committee is then asked to agree which activities to fund through the Well Being funding.
- 8. Subject to the amount allocated to a Youth Programme for Stockwood, Hengrove and Whitchurch NP the Neighbourhood Committee is asked approve up to £2,000 for the production of publicity and promotional material for the yearlong youth programme.

Legal Information

When councillors decide how the wellbeing fund is spent they should have due regard to the public sector equality duty that applies to all public bodies. This duty is contained in the Equality Act 2010 and came in to force on 6 April 2011. It replaces previous equality duties under the Sex Discrimination, Race Relations and Disability Discrimination Acts.

The duty means that councillors are required to have due regard to the need to:

- Eliminate unlawful discrimination, harassment and victimisation and other conduct prohibited under the Act
- Promote equality of opportunity between different groups
- Foster good relations between people from different groups

The duty covers the following protected characteristics:

• Disability, Sexual orientation, Age, Gender reassignment, Religion and belief; Sex, Race, Pregnancy and maternity.

It also applies to marriage and civil partnership, but only in respect of the requirement to eliminate discrimination and harassment.
