## 5.0 s106 budgets

### 5.0a Section 106 for Stockwood Library (on Appendix 7a).

There has been some confusion around this funding as officers in the Library Service thought this funding was allocated to them directly to spend within the library. We have now clarified this and can confirm that the full Section 106 allocation is in a ring fenced budget waiting for elected members within the Neighbourhood Partnership to make the final decision on how to spend the funding. None of this money has been spent. A consultation is currently being arranged for the wider community and the library users to consider what they would like to propose for spending this funding. We hope to bring a proposal for decision to the next Neighbourhood Partnership.

Following many repeated requests from ClIrs Jethwa and Morris regarding this spend (since the allocation of this money) to Library staff at all levels and not receiving a satisfactory response from anyone, ClIr Jethwa complained to the Service Director and Head of Libraries. As a result of ClIr Jethwa's complaint a meeting was arranged by the Director of Services and Head of Library, from which the above outcome on the way forward has been agreed.
