1. Membership and chairing arrangements

- 1.1 The St George Neighbourhood Partnership comprises of:
 - i. 4 X local councillors forming the Neighbourhood Committee (NC).
 - ii. Independent resident living or working in the St George area.
 - iii. Local community/voluntary organisations and faith communities
 - iv. 2 X young people
 - v. 2 X local businesses
 - vi. 1 X Equalities
- 1.2 See appendix 1 for full list of the St George NP membership.
- 1.3 The chairing arrangements for the St George NP for 2014-15 will be determined at the NP meeting on Tuesday 24th June 2014.

2. Terms of Reference and Financial Operating Framework

- 2.1 The Neighbourhood Committee and Neighbourhood Partnership terms of reference are the same as last years, but are in the process of being reviewed. They are available on NP website or on request from the NP Co-ordinator.
- 2.2 The financial operating framework for the NC remains the same as 2013/14 and is available on the NP website or on request from the NP Co-ordinator.

3 Devolved budgets and influence on services 2014/15

- 3.1 The Partnership is asked to note that the following powers are devolved to councillors for decision, following discussion at a partnership meeting and taking account of the views expressed:
 - i. Expenditure of well-being budget;
 - ii. Expenditure of budget for environment projects;
 - iii. Highways maintenance (i.e. road surface dressing/renewal and footway reconstruction/resurfacing);
 - iv. Local traffic schemes;
 - v. Decisions relating to council-owned community centres and buildings;
 - vi. Spending locally, money paid to the Council under Section 106 agreements/Community Infrastructure Levy and prioritising site specific schemes to be funded from that source.
