## **Evidence Base / Context**

In Autumn of 2023, Bristol Waste implemented a re-route to re-balance the collections rounds to improve performance, generate savings and increase the narrow access rounds. The initial re-route was not successful. Two further re-routes were implemented to improve performance.
