Recommendation:

- 1) That the Neighbourhood Partnership **approves** the recommendations from the Dundry View Funding panel for the allocation of Transformer Grants Funding.
 - a) **Approve** £1415 towards LPW work on the Pod based in Withywood Park and give thanks to Withywood Forum and Park Group who will contribute a further £600 to the work.
 - b) **Approve** £1500 towards Room 13's new project with the creation of films by the children and young people about the area particularly Dundry Slopes as well as setting up a You Tube channel to stream the films

1. The Dundry View Neighbourhood Partnership was given £5000 from the Police Community Trust to allocate out to groups that benefit children and young people (8-19years) in December due to the budget freeze of the small grants pots a decision was taken to allocate some of the £5000 to applicants who met the Transformers criteria. This amounted to £2085 leaving £2915 to allocate in this round.
2. The Dundry View Neighbourhood Partnership has a Funding Panel that meets to discuss funding applications received and to make recommendations to the full partnership for allocating the transformers funding. The panel is made up of local residents and councillors.

3. The panel met on 27th February 2017 and made the recommendations contained in the table below:
4. After the meeting the Withywood Forum and Park Group offered £600 towards the LPW work in Withywood Park allowing extra funding to be allocated to Room 13 as the panel felt both were very worthy local groups with sustainable outcomes. Unique Voice was also felt to be a good project but as funds were limited it was agreed that the money should be spent on the two previously mentioned
