


## Do you think that the lighting level on St John's Road is (45 responses)




## Where do you live? (45 responses)





St John's Road is in a Conservation Area, meaning that lampposts etc. should be of a sympathetic historical design. However, authentic cast iron lampposts are half the height of standard lampposts (meaning that you need 40% more lampposts to provide the same lighting level on the pavement), and they do not have enough space inside them for the electrical hardware (meaning an extra compartment on the outside is needed). So the Council is trialling a new approach where it refurbishes old cast iron lampposts to extend the height and build an electrics compartment inside, out of sight. An alternative option is to install traditional design lampposts, but new and made of steel. Which do you think would be best for St John's Road?
