1	Young and Equal	To develop Young Equality Champions; team up with Equality Forums to run an equalities youth conference in 2018; produce a pledge and charter standard; carry out a survey of young people's experiences,; develop a social media presence.
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2	What Next for 15-18 Year Olds	To create more work experience opportunities; create platform for educational establishments and employers to work together and promote existing platforms; provide support to young people post-work experience to help develop opportunities; work with Listening Partnership Disability Forum for disabled young people; improve careers advice.
3	Education for Life	Update the current PSHE curriculum to: properly equip teachers with materials and discussion points; improve training for PSHE teachers; extend Create Centre sessions to KS4 students (currently provided to younger students); work with UK Youth Parliament on Curriculum for Life Campaign.
4	Youth Voice	Release a BCYC broadcast to promote what we do; run a Youth conference in October 2017 during National Democracy Week to discuss political engagement and issues facing young people; reach out to youth groups to explain the work of the youth council.
