Purpose of the report

Context

1. An application for the summary review of the premises licence in respect of Elm Tree, Queens Road, Bishopsworth, Bristol BS13 8HP was submitted by The Chief Constable Of Avon And Somerset Constabulary on 9 February 2018 on the grounds that it is the opinion of a Senior Police Officer of Avon and Somerset Constabulary that the premises are associated with serious crime or serious disorder or both.

The premises licence holder is Star Pubs & Bars Limited and the current Designated Premises Supervisor is Martise Marie Pye

Recommendations:

The Authority must consider any interim steps they may wish to consider with having regard to the application and accompanying documentation and may take such of the steps mentioned below, if any, as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives. In making this (and all licensing decisions) the sub-committee must have regard to the guidance and policy included in the sub-committee's pack

The steps are—

- (a) the modification of the conditions of the premises licence,
- (b) the exclusion of a licensable activity from the scope of the licence,
- (c) the removal of the designated premises supervisor from the licence,
- (d) the suspension of the licence
