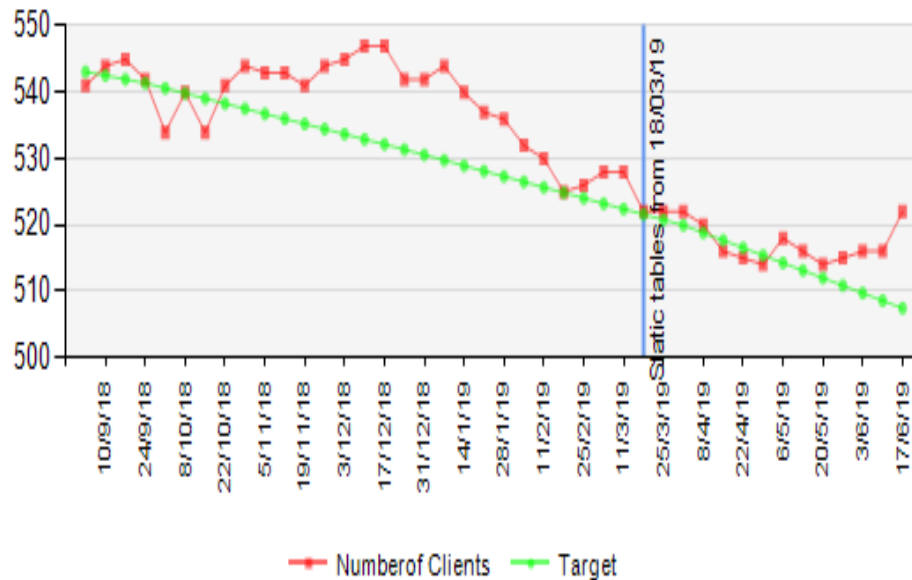

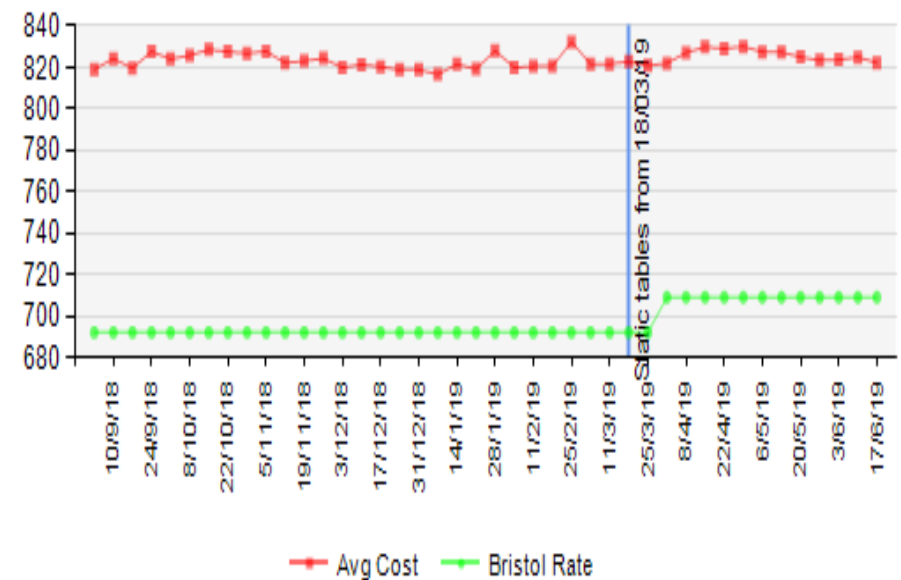

Average Weekly Cost in Residential Care for agegroup 65+



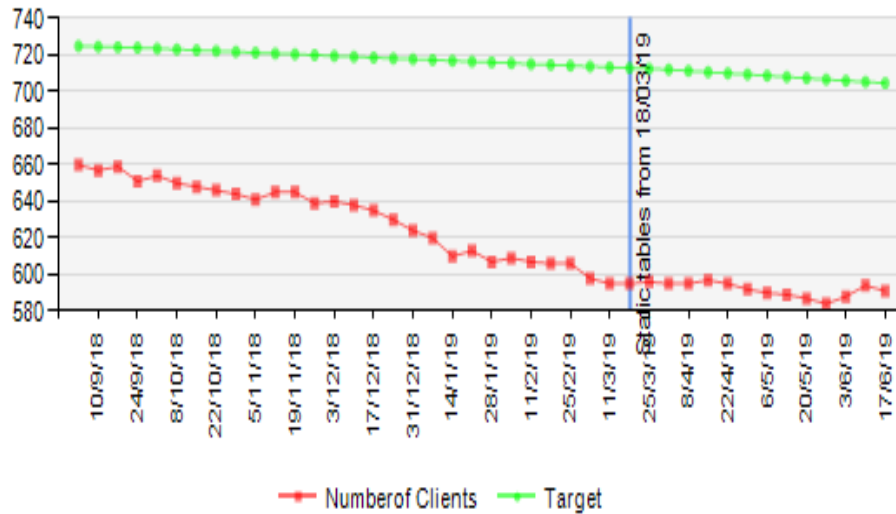
- **Increase in residential placements – concerning**

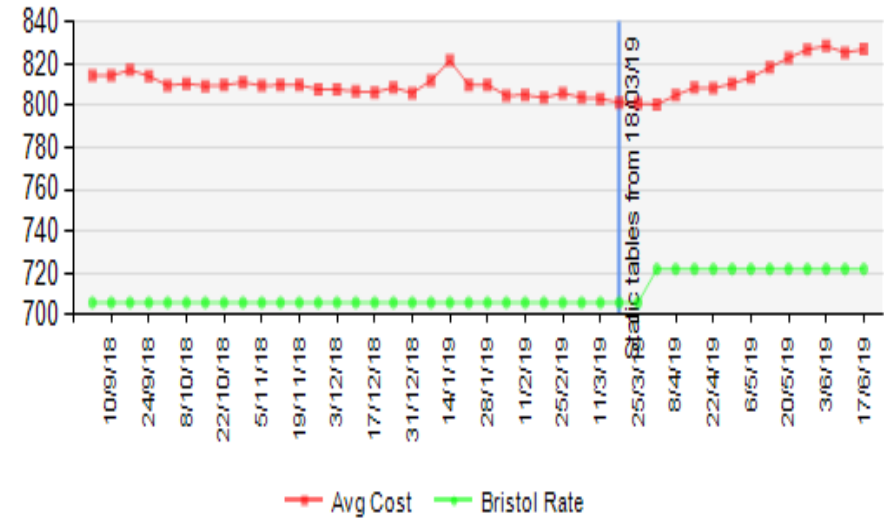

Number of Clients in Nursing Care for agegroup 65+

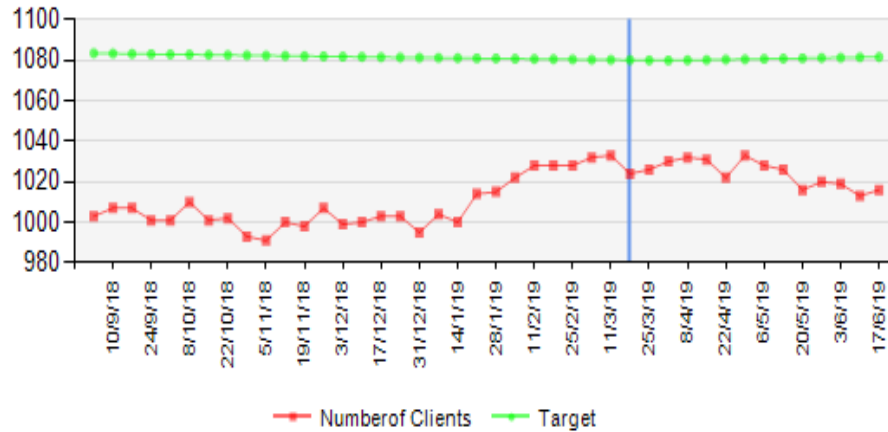


Average Weekly Cost in Nursing Care for agegroup 65+

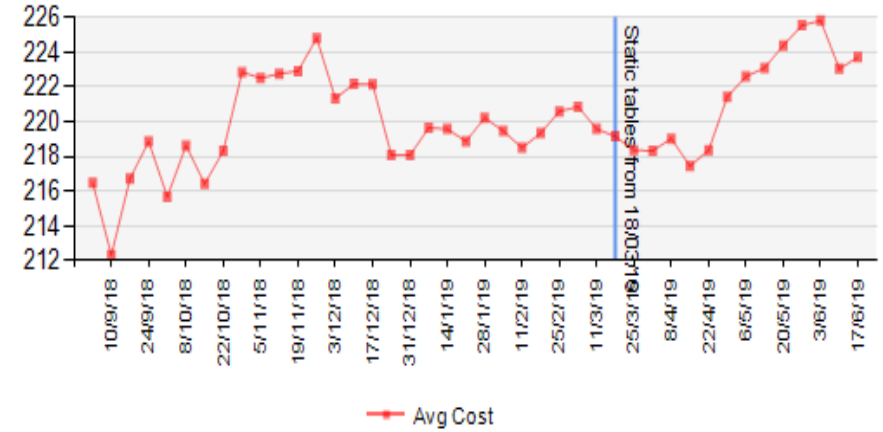


- **Small increase in nursing**

  - 1 – Likely CHC

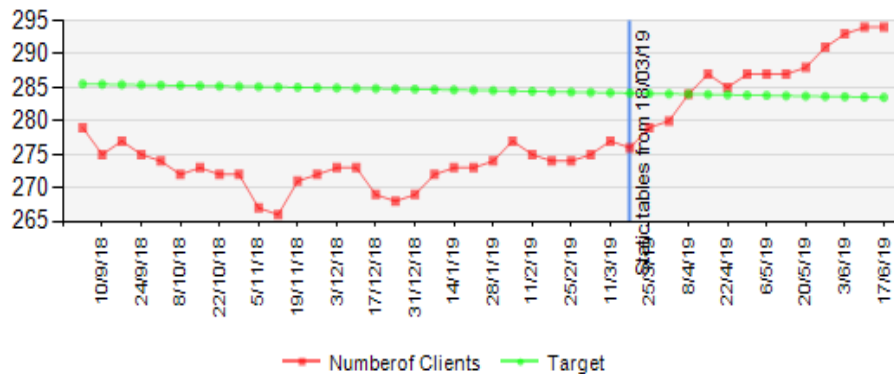
Number of Clients in Home Care for agegroup 65+



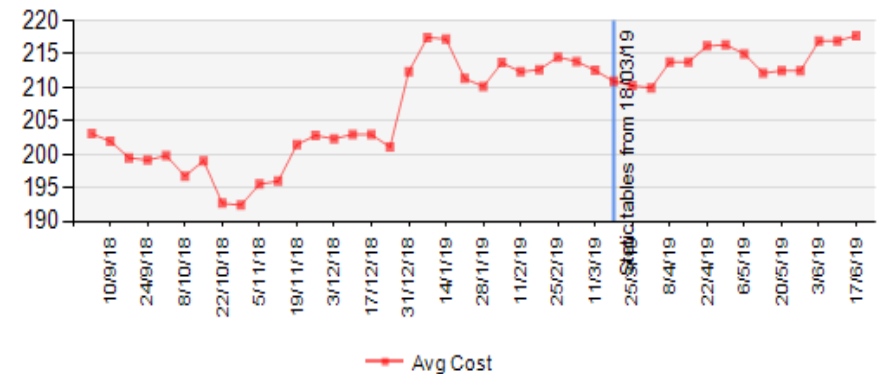
Average Weekly Cost in Home Care for agegroup 65+



Number of Clients in Home Care for agegroup 18-64

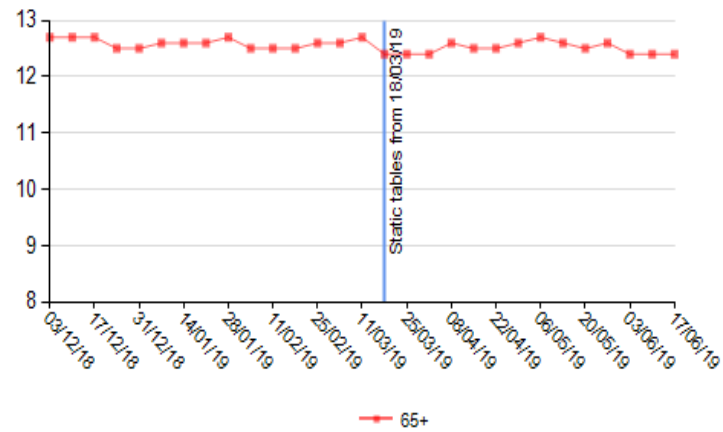


Average Weekly Cost in Home Care for agegroup 18-64

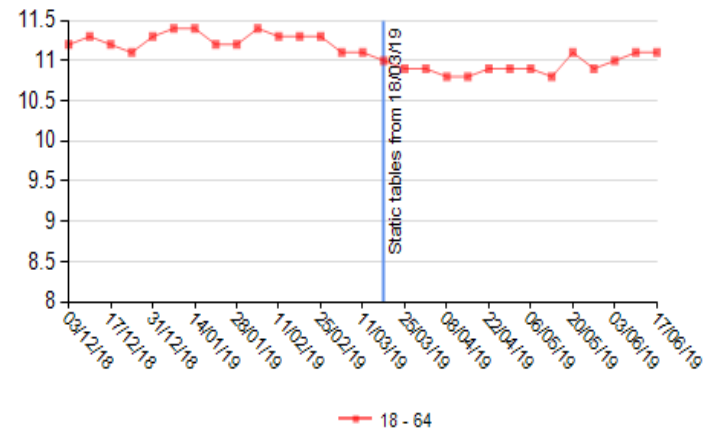


- Increase in no of 18-64 receiving home care. Further analysis taking place
- No of new homecare packages this month reduced – from 29 to 24.

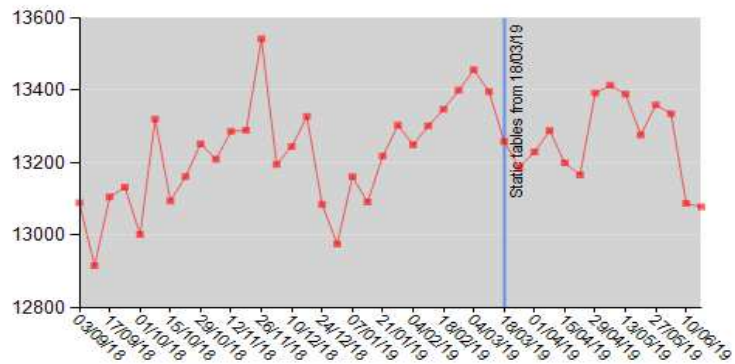
Average hours of home care for 65+



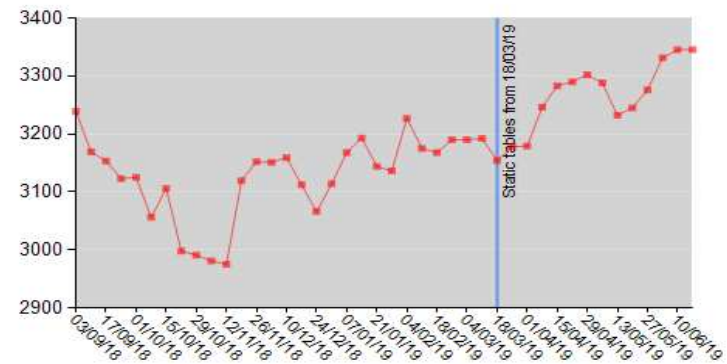
Average hours of home care for 18 - 64

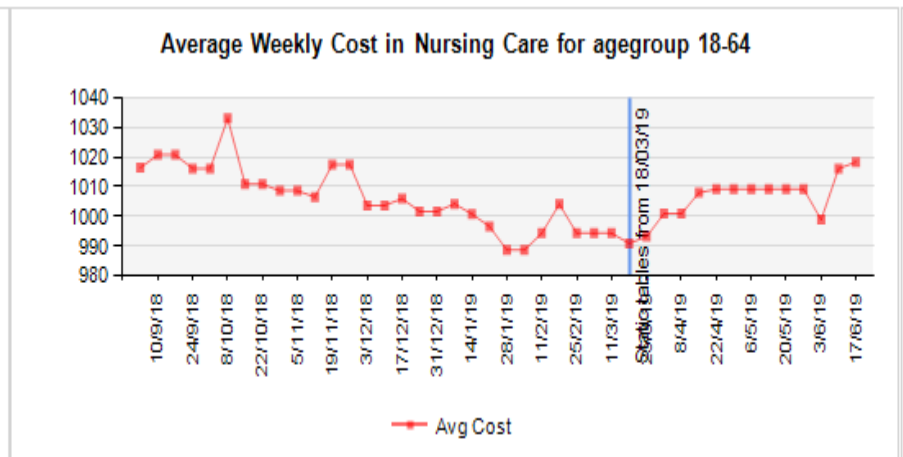
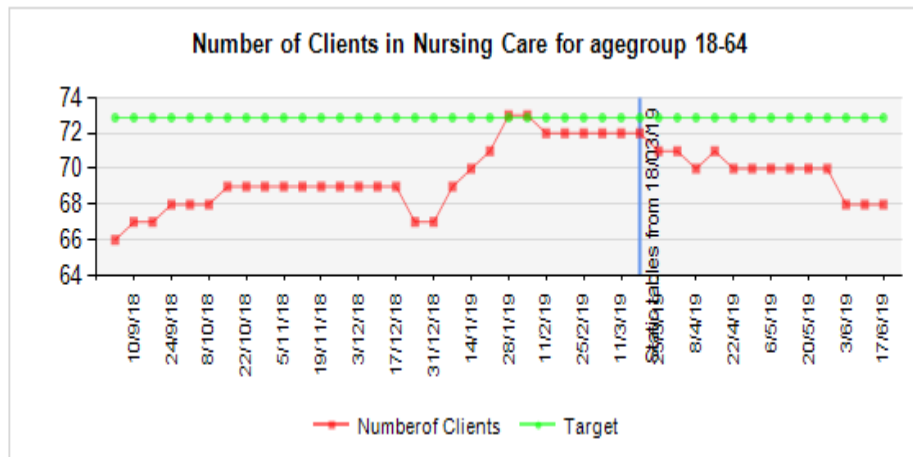
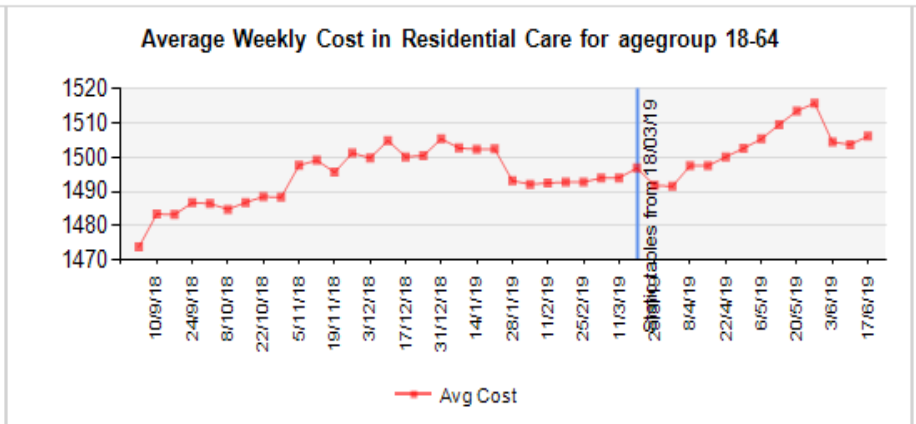
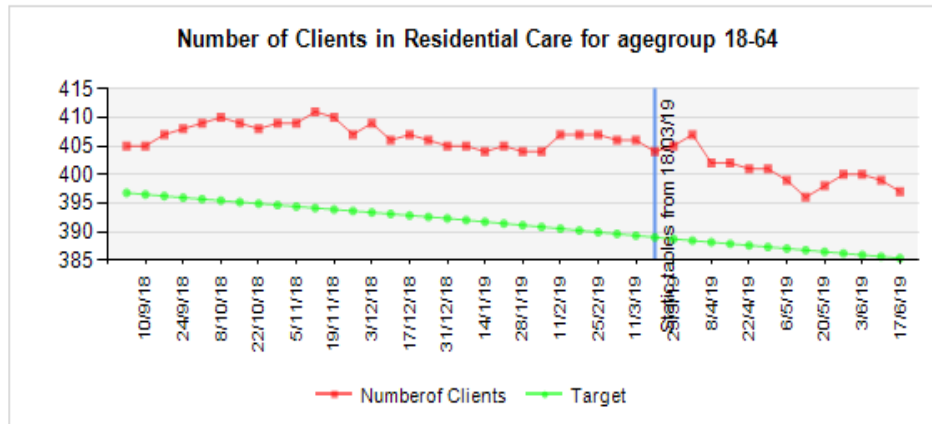


Number of Home Care hours for each weekstart for 65+



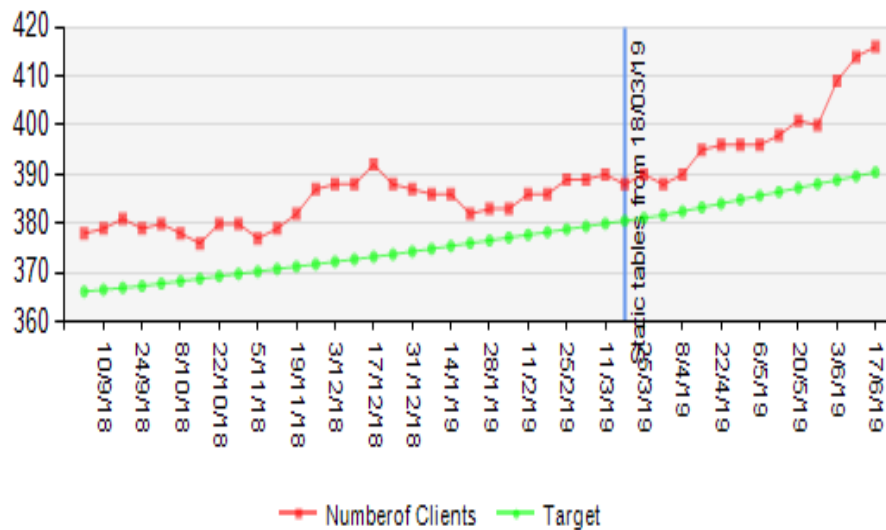
Number of Home Care hours for each weekstart for 18-64



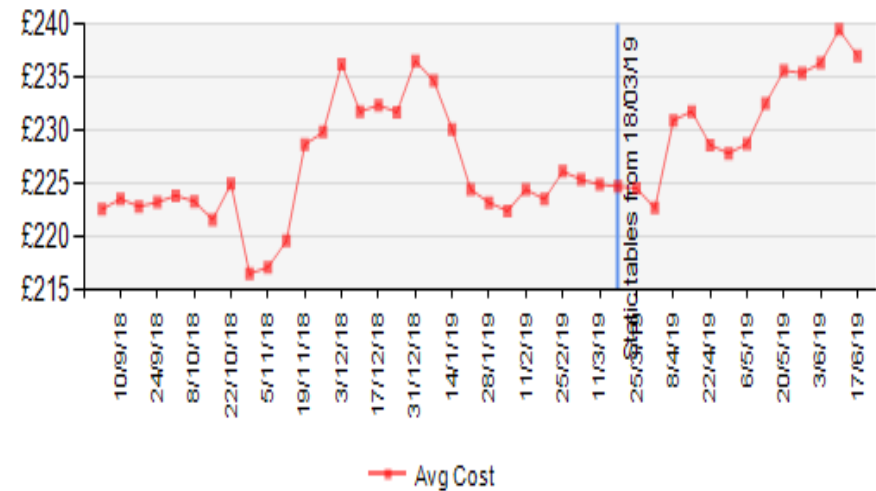

Clients receiving support under an ECH contract - all ages

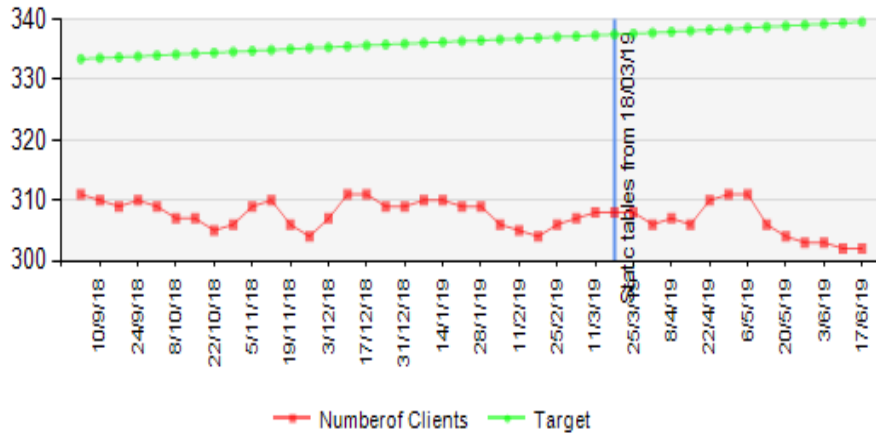


Average Weekly Cost for Clients receiving support under an ECH contract - all ages

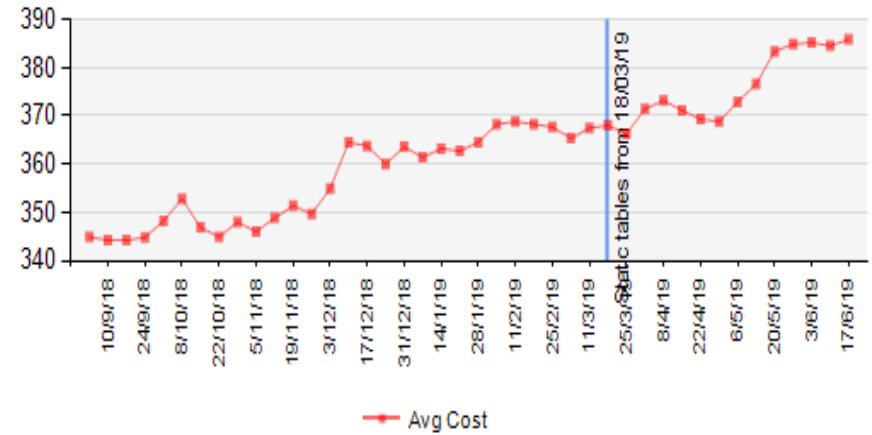


- **ECH placements have increased in line with new capacity available**
- **Continued new capacity will support reduction in residential care**

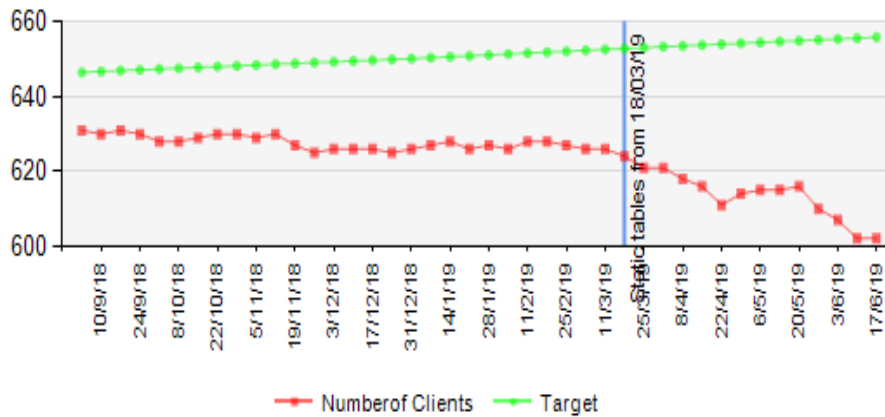
**Number of Clients with Direct Payments for agegroup 65+**



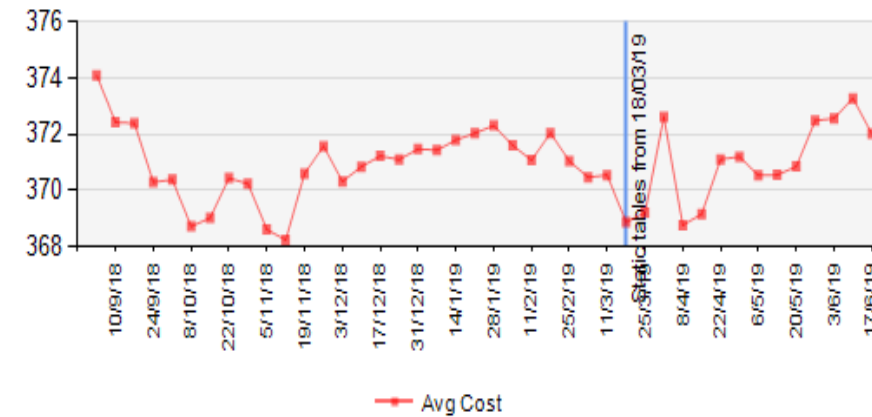
**Average Weekly Cost of Direct Payments for agegroup 65+**



**Number of Clients with Direct Payments for agegroup 18-64**

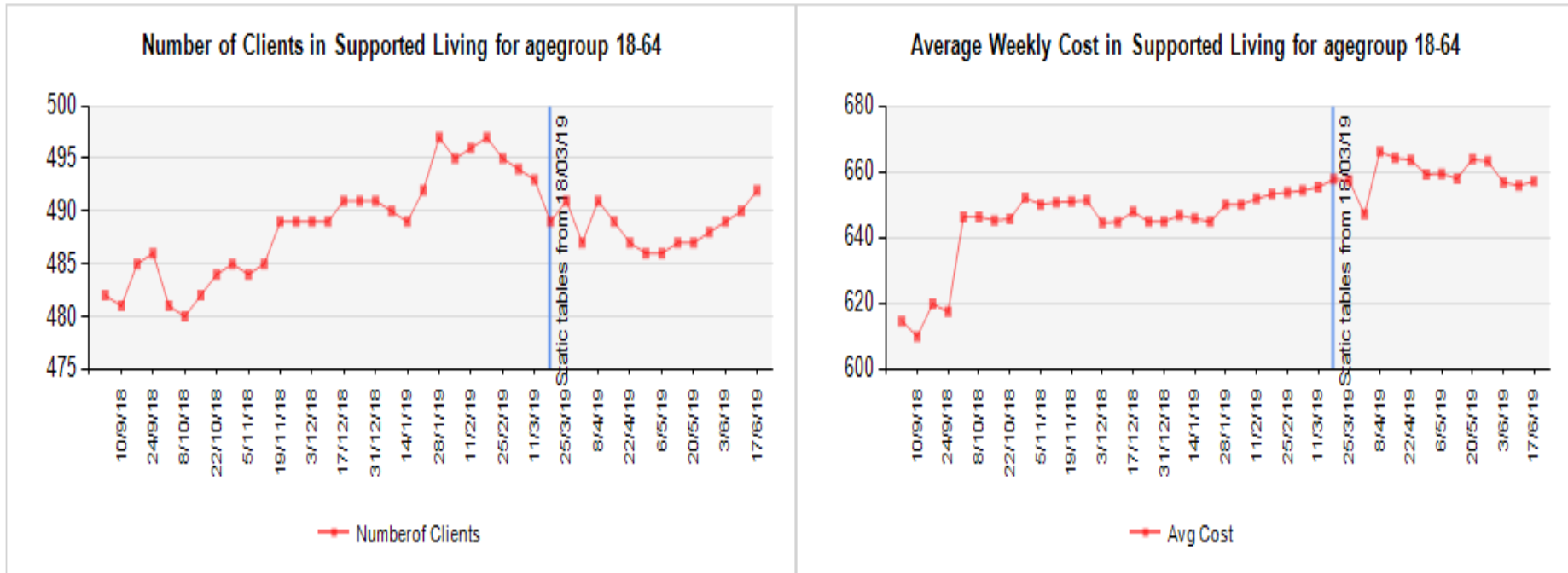


**Average Weekly Cost of Direct Payments for agegroup 18-64**

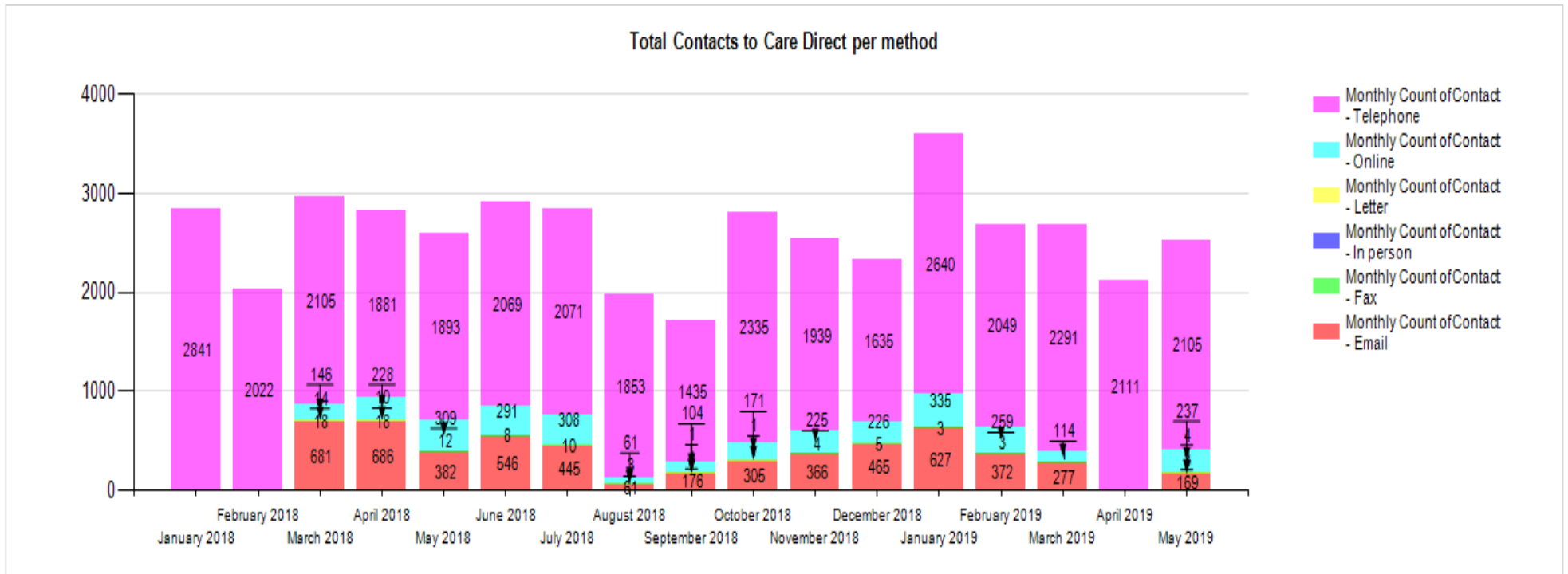


- **Current no of DP's is under target- further work planned.**

- **April data may be under reporting due to process changes.**

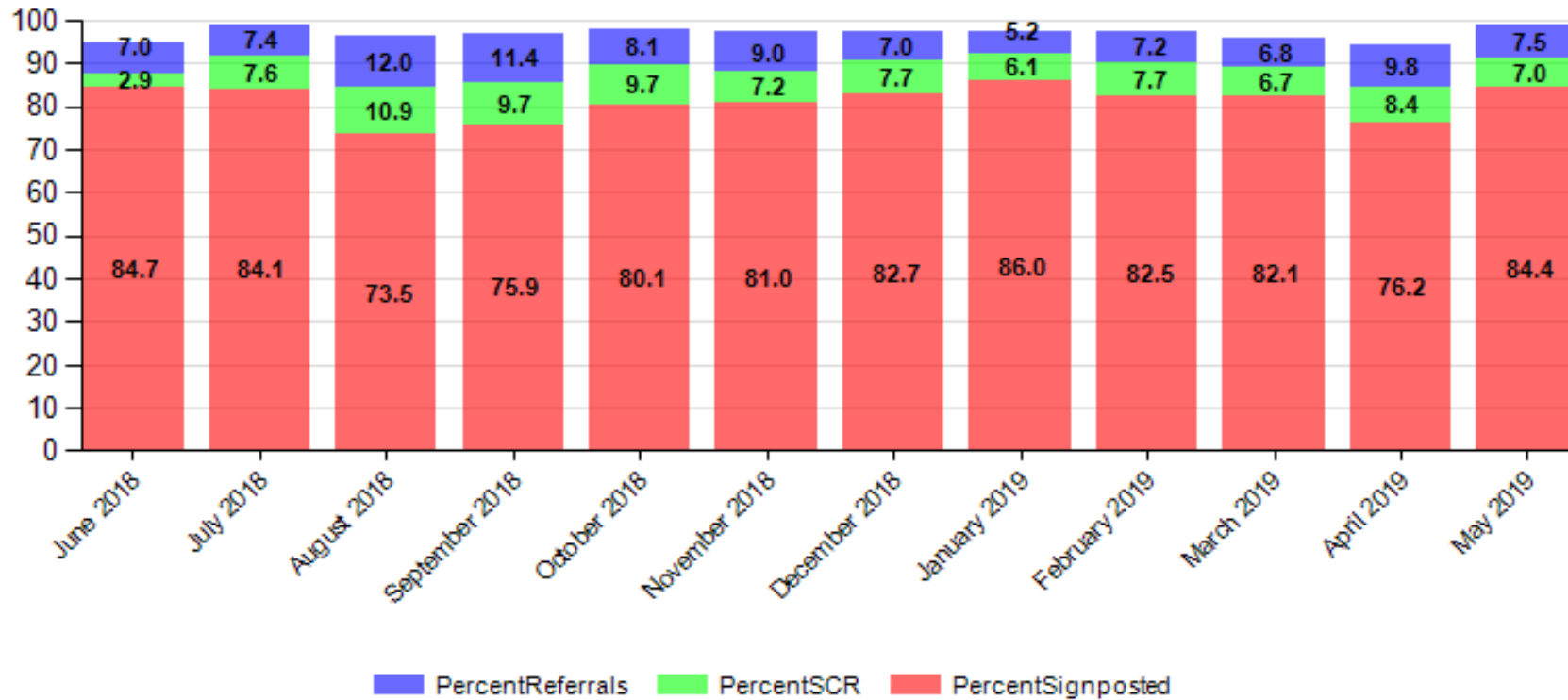

- Reduction of % of referrals needed

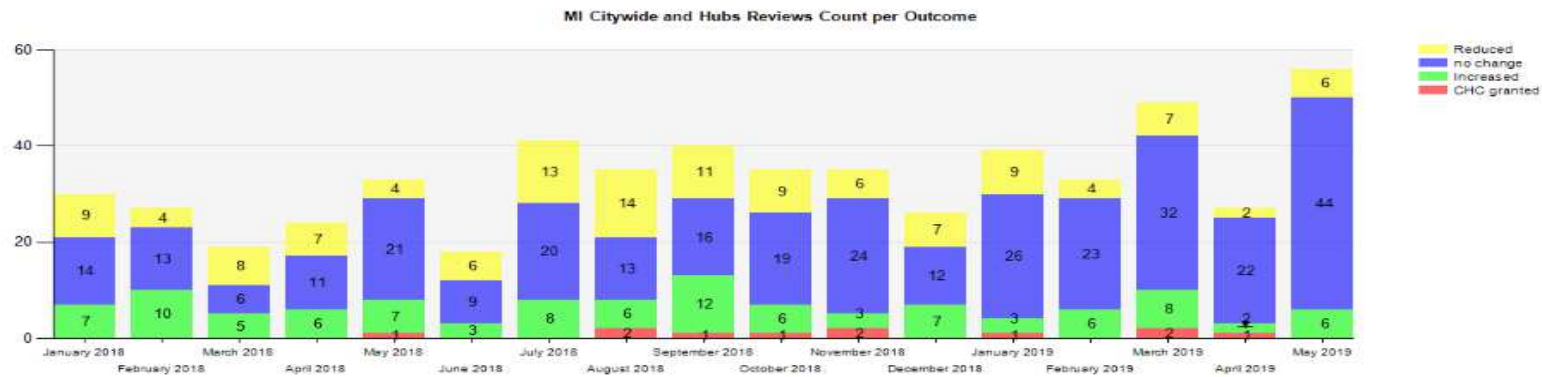
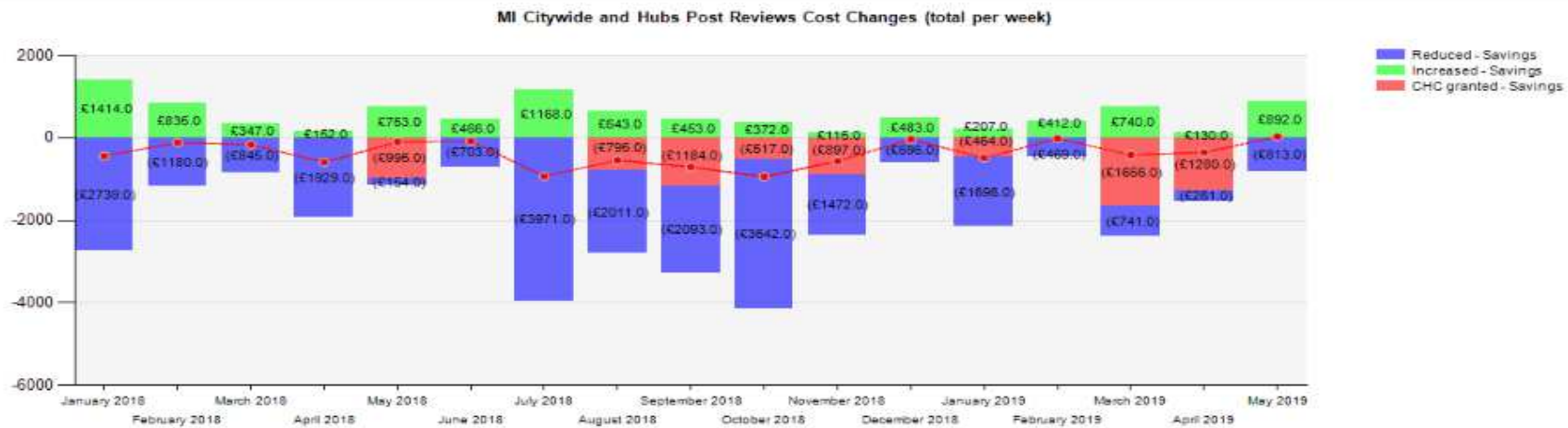


- No of completed reviews and planned reviews remains high

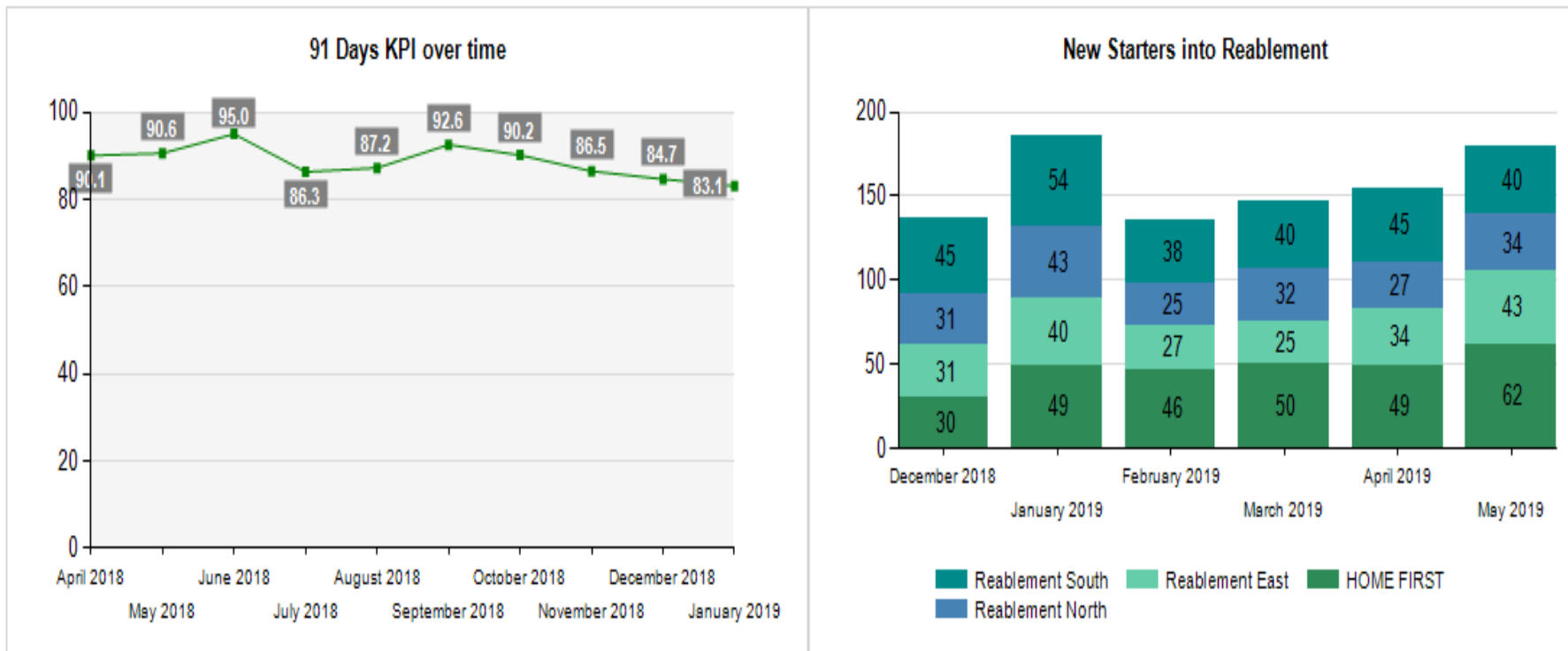

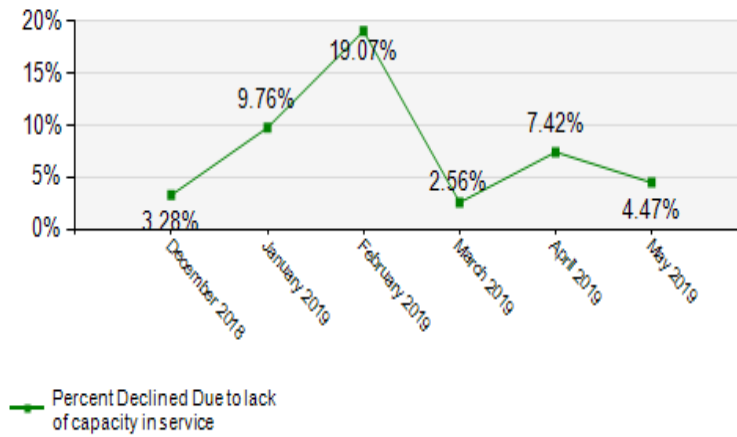




Average weekly caseload for the whole Reablement Service
