



Better Lives Trajectory Management Summary for May 2019

 - 1 property case











- Small increase in nursing

- No of new homecare packages this month reduced from 29 to 24.










- No of Res & Nursing care for 18-64 slowly reducing

- All new placements desktop reviewed






- ECH placements have increased in line with new capacity available
- Continued new capacity will support reduction in residential care






Current no of DP's is under target- further work planned.






- No of clients in SP increasing a positive trend

- April data may be under reporting due to process changes.


Activity breakdown by percentage of total contacts

- Reduction of % of referrals needed





Number of Planned or Unplanned Reviews
