4	Brislington West	Grant	19/03253/F - 90 - 92 Wick Road Bristol BS4 4HF Extension and change of use from residential use (Class C3 of the Use Classes Order) to Sui Generis use to create a House in Multiple Occupation (HMO).
5	Westbury-on-Trym & Henleaze	Grant	19/03847/H - 16 Berkeley Road Westbury Park Bristol BS6 7PJ Single storey ground floor/side infill extension.
