Director of Education & Skills	<p>COMPLETED</p> <p>Number of eligible 2YO's based on DWP Data November 2021 = 1,519 Take up from the January Headcount: Number of funded 2YOs = 1,086 (71.5%) Number of those children who are a Bristol resident = 1,052 (69.3%)</p> <p>When the Department for Education publish their numbers they do include children who attend from out of authority, usually at 3%.</p> <p>Parent Champions Scheme in Bristol: Parent Champions are parent volunteers who give a few hours a week to talk to other parents about childcare and other local services available to families. Only some two year olds are eligible for free childcare, which can make it more difficult to make sure that families know about it and the benefits of childcare. In Bristol our Parent Champions focus on the two-year-old free childcare offer supporting parents eligible for free childcare to find out about, engage with and access this service to improve outcomes for themselves and their children. Having accessed free childcare themselves, Parent Champions share how the</p>

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				offer works and signpost to further support. As parents themselves, drawn from their local communities, they are ideally placed to communicate information and their own positive experiences of using local services to parents in a way that is relatable, meaningful, and more likely to be acted upon. This model works particularly well for communities that are considered hard to reach, who are often less likely to access services, therefore our current Parent Champions are promoting the 2YO offer in the Lawrence Hill and Hartcliffe and Witherwood wards in Bristol where take up of the offer is particularly low.

The current risk rating is classified as 'High', however does not qualify for automatic inclusion within the Corporate Risk Report. Risks can be considered by EDMs for escalation to the Corporate Risk Report if they it becomes too unwieldy to manage within its current level or cannot be controlled and remain very high, even after mitigation.
