**CURRENT CLAIMS, INQUIRIES AND MISCELLANEOUS RIGHTS OF WAY MATTERS**

(Report of the Executive Director for Transport, Growth and Regeneration directorate)

(Ward: Citywide)

**Purpose of Report**

1. To report for information on the present position with regard to claims under Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981; public inquiries; and miscellaneous rights of way orders, agreements and legal proceedings.
2. To inform members on the public right of way improvements made during 2020 – 2022 and the proposed improvements planned for 2022/2023.

**Background**

2. As Surveying Authority for the purposes of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 the City Council has a duty, as imposed by Section 53(2)(b) of the Act, to keep the Definitive Map and Statement under continuous review and to determine any valid applications for Modification Orders which it receives.
3. There are currently eleven outstanding claims that are waiting to be determined by the Authority, the most recent of which was validated by Legal Services in November 2019. See table at Appendix A for present position with applications.
4. There is no statutory advice relating to the order in which claims should be processed. However, the Council's standard practice is to deal with each application in chronological order of receipt, unless the claim is affected by a planning application in which case it is prioritised.
5. The area of work undertaken by the prow team is guided by statute and the targets set out in the Rights of Way Improvement Plan (ROWIP) 2019-2026. The ROWIP is a Highway Authority requirement under the Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000.
6. The list of completed improvement works for 2020-2022 is attached at appendix D. These works have been carried out under the Highway and Surveying Authorities duties; to assert and protect the rights of the public, to ensure routes are adequately signposted, maintained free from obstruction and fit for purpose and, to keep the definitive map and statement under continuous review.

7. The proposed improvement work plan and strategy for 2022/23 is attached at appendix E.

## APPENDIX (C)

### Legal Event Modification Orders

The duty of the Surveying Authority (SA) is to keep and maintain the legal record of public rights of way. The Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (W&C Act) replaced the requirement to revise the map every 5 years, with the duty to keep the definitive map and statement under constant review by means of modification orders. If a way is shown on the map, then that is legal, or conclusive, evidence that the public had those rights along the way at the relevant date of the map (and still has them, unless there has been a legally authorised change). It is therefore conclusive as to what it does show, however the reverse is not true. If a way is not shown on the definitive map, then this is not proof that the public has no right over it. In practice the definitive map is a minimum record of the known rights, and the statement describes and gives details for each route. Under the legislation of Section 53 of the W&C Act, applications can be made to change the Definitive Map and Statement as other rights may exist which are not yet shown on the map.

The Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000 (CRoW Act) included an amendment to W&C Act, S53A. Section 51 and paragraph 2 of Schedule 5 to the CRoW Act a new section 53A into the W&C Act 1981. The Combined Orders Regulations were published in 2010 [S.I. 2010 No. 2127]. The amendment permits a combined process for SA's so that public path orders processed by them can provide a mechanism for modifying the map and statement concurrently with the coming into operation of the public path order. This obviates the need for separate legal event orders to be sealed in the future but the regulations did not backdate to the relevant date of the Defintive Map and Statement. This measure came into force on the 6 April 2008. Therefore, in Bristol there is a backlog of legal events which had taken place between 1966 and 2008, a period of 42 years. During the last 3 years a specific project to undertake this work has been progressing. The following tables in Appendix C includes all the orders which have been made and sealed, those about to be sealed and those legal events which remain to be investigated.
