Recommendation:

- 1) That the Neighbourhood Committee **approves** the recommendations from the Dundry View Funding panel for the allocation of Small Grants Funding.
 - a) Award BABEs @ Zion £1270 towards running and training of the group
 - b) Award Hartcliffe & Withywood Angling Club £800
 - c) Award LPW - Millennium Children's Group £500 to improve the path at their Millennium Green location
 - d) Award St Peters Activity Centre £1500 towards the new project and provide facilities within it.
 - e) Award Young Bristol - The Grove £785 towards new outdoor furniture.
 - f) Award HWV Wednesday group £515 towards their activities and events
 - g) Award Zion £720 towards a local area history and museum
 - h) Award Kingshead Park Group £75.60 towards whips to be planted in the park.
- 2) That the remaining budget is focussed on Children and Young people

1. The Dundry View Neighbourhood Partnership has **£28,982** available funding in the Small Grants (Wellbeing Budget). (£1,018 allocated in Dec 2015 from this year's budget)

2. The Dundry View Neighbourhood Partnership has a Funding Panel that meets to discuss funding applications received and to make

recommendations to the Neighbourhood Committee for allocating the funding. The panel is made up of local residents and councillors.

3. The panel met on 14 November 2016 and made the recommendations contained in the table below:
4. The panel also recommended that the remaining budget is combined with agenda item 8 and that applications for the February grants favour work with children and young people and ways they can enable progression of the neighbourhood plan.
